Garwood was one of two schools in Idaho recognized for this prestigious annual distinguished schools award program. This award recognizes outstanding achievements by Title I schools from each state. Garwood Elementary out-performed 88.6 percent of other Idaho schools in the measure of mathematics proficiency. Between 2015 and 2017, Garwood increased our mathematics proficiency rate by 13.5%, with strong improvement in the performance of students with disabilities. Getting to accept our award on behalf of the dedicated teachers and students whose hard work is always valued and now nationally-recognized was an incredible honor.

We have a fabulous PTO and group of parents who support and participate this wonderful organization. A huge thank you to all the families that brought in soups, salads and desserts for our workday in November. It is rare that we get time to gather as a staff to enjoy a meal together and it provided us this opportunity. The food was delicious and much appreciated.

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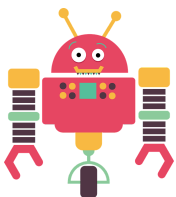


**WHERE:** Garwood Elementary
